VINTAGE NOTES

This Shiraz was picked from Block 7 which is a single block of the original vines planted on the estate in 1987. The soil is sand over gravel or clay and is vinified using various techniques.

The block is split into two batches. The first is fermented in open pots, requiring continual hand-plunging over five days before finishing fermentation in French oak barriques. The remaining fruit is fermented in a closed tank, worked for five days and then allowed to soak on skins for a further two weeks. The resulting wine is drained off skins to French oak barriques where it completes malolactic fermentation. Both wines have spent 15 months on French oak, with the resultant wine the best blend from the best barriques.

ANALYSIS

Alcohol 13.5%, pH 3.38, TA 6.7 g/L

TASTING NOTES

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| Colour | Deep crimson red in colour with brilliant purple hues. |
| Aroma | Loaded with primary fruit aromas of blueberries, blackberries, and violets, the wine has an alluring charm with complex cedar and earthy spice notes adding intrigue. |
| Palate | Dry, medium- to full-bodied, the wine maintains a delicate balance between elegance and power. |
